Nano-electromechanical switch and its application in electronic memory Javad Farajollahi^{1,*}

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Abstract

Nano-electromechanical switches are similar to ordinary semiconductor switches, but the performance principles of nano-electromechanical and semiconductor switch is different. Due to the optimal situation which is created in nano-electromechanical switch technology, they can be replaced to semiconductor technology.
